The Virtua Early Intervention Program:

- ❖ Has been a comprehensive service provider to eligible children in Burlington County since 1978.
- ❖ Was awarded comprehensive status in Camden County in November 2013.
- ❖ Is the designated Targeted Evaluation Team in Burlington.
- ❖ Is the back-up Targeted Evaluation Team in Camden County.

The number of children treated has steadily grown throughout the years of the program's operation.

- ✧ In 2013: 938 children received 28,248 services.
- ✧ In 2014: 1552 children have received 32,721 services.

The Virtua Early Intervention Program (EIP) provides a variety of therapeutic and support services to help infants, toddlers, and their families who have been found eligible for services through the New Jersey Early Intervention System (NJEIS). The Early Intervention Team is composed of 86 members including:

- ◆ Behaviorists
- ◆ Occupational Therapists
- ◆ Physical Therapists
- ◆ Social Workers
- ◆ Speech Therapists
- ◆ Teachers of the Handicapped
- ◆ Teachers of the Deaf
